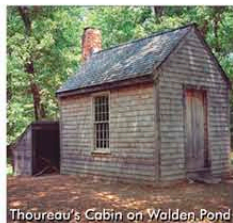
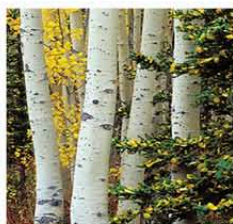

Neighborhood Parks
High use park sites, like the one you're in now, are distributed in a comprehensive manner to serve local residential cells with both active & passive recreational opportunities

Walden Preserve Stage I
A linear open space system linking a prominent neighborhood park to the school site. This linear open space meanders throughout Walden, allowing the preservation of existing vegetation, providing regional & local pathway connections & accommodating storm water management features

ECO Park Stage I
This storm water management facility has been transformed into a vibrant re-constructed wetland. It incorporates trail networks, viewing nodes and interpretive elements to create a valuable recreation & educational amenity

ECO Park Stage II
Through the integration of Low Impact Development strategies for storm water management & landscape naturalization techniques, the stage II Eco Park provides important habitat for local wildlife as well as a significant open space amenity for local residents

Enhanced Streetscape
By utilizing prototypical road construction standards, Walden's street network shall be green & tree lined. The boulevards shall harvest storm water runoff in key locations & will in essence self irrigate - reducing demand on potable water usage & discharge to the Bow River

Walden Preserve Stage II
Linear open space system linking two prominent neighborhood parks. The system meanders through Walden while preserving existing vegetation, providing regional & local pathway connections & accommodating LID features
